INTRODUCTION

The Facilitation Certification Accreditation program is designed specifically for organizations that provide facilitator certification to individuals. Accreditation is based on INIFAC's Facilitator Competencies and given to a specific certification and not to a organization with a variety of certifications.

INIFAC's comprehensive evaluation of certification processes recognizes individual companies for their effort in assessing the facilitator competencies of; Presence, Assessment, Communication, Control, Consistency, and Engagement. By accrediting a certification process, INIFAC confirms that the applicant is being assessed for knowledge, skills, and experience necessary for a person to demonstrate Applicant's standards and methodology.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this program is to provide a confirmation and independent assurance that your facilitation certification assesses the knowledge, experience, and skills, for certification.

When a program is accredited, it will be listed on INIFAC's website as well as offered to organizations who are engaged in INIFAC's Partners in Facilitator Development program (PIFD).

ACCREDITATION CRITERIA

For a certification process to be accredited by INIFAC, the following four criteria must be met.

- 1. Use the same or reasonably similar rubric format INIFAC uses for its assessments—a scaled assessment based on knowledge, skills, and experience.
 - NOTE: INIFAC's sub-competencies must NOT be changed or altered.
- 2. Recommended components: Written, live/video demonstration, experience, references (if appropriate.)
- 3. Example of scoring: 5-point system with definitions of what descriptors on what qualifies for 1, 3, and 5 points.
- 4. Cover at least 75% of the sub-competencies in at least four of the six competency areas; the Consistency competency must be included to ensure coverage of basic facilitation skills.
- Provide a process acceptable to INIFAC for accessing the skills in the INIFAC competency areas (this acceptance will be approved by the INIFAC board).
- 6. Guarantee that any changes made to INIFAC's assessment competencies first meet INIFAC board approval.

ACCREDITION BY INIFAC

Organizations that have successfully completed the assessment process will receive a Certificate of Accreditation for the specific. This accreditation will be good for one year and may be renewed annually.
